To mark the 45th anniversary of International Whores' Day (IWD), NYC-based sex worker rights activists are staging an online rally and social media takeover on June 2, 2020, honoring the global protests taking place annually. The **IWD NYC Digital Rally** is a celebration of the resilience of sex working communities and a call to action in their fight for human rights.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

June 2, 2020 marks the 45th International Whores' Day (IWD), a global event that started in Lyon, France in 1975 when <u>over 100 sex workers protested</u> the violence and police brutality targeting their livelihood. Every year on June 2, sex workers around the world honor IWD by protesting the injustices they face, organizing community celebrations, and educating the public on the harmful policies affecting their survival and the need for the decriminalization of sex work.

On June 2, 2020, New York City-based sex workers are hosting the <u>IWD NYC Digital Rally</u>, where sex worker organizers will speak on how they are surviving and caring for their communities. As a form of direct action, sex workers, sex work adjacent organizations, and allies worldwide will flood social media with graphics, art, and selfies featuring red, the color of sex work pride and protest.

Recognizing the importance of art and storytelling in sex worker organizing, the **IWD NYC 2020 Coalition** is also launching the <u>IWD NYC 2020 Zine</u>, a collaboration between 20 sex workers and co-strugglers documenting their experiences, art, and forms of resistance under the current racist, anti-immigrant, classist, homophobic, transphobic, and misogynistic U.S. laws.

Sex workers cannot survive in the age of COVID-19 if they cannot work online. In 2018, <u>FOSTA/SESTA devastated</u> the sex industry by penalizing third-party online platforms for facilitating sexual commerce. COVID-19 related social distancing guidelines have forced sex workers to transition online, in spite of the risk of deplatforming, censorship, and surveillance. The recently proposed EARN IT act only further threatens sex workers' precarious existence online. The **IWD NYC Digital Rally** will highlight sex workers' stories of COVID-19 survival, the urgent need for the decarceration of sex workers, the impact of government legislation like <u>FOSTA/SESTA</u> and <u>EARN IT</u> on sex workers' livelihoods, and the need for the immediate decriminalization of sex work.
